Why London for medical & pharmaceutical meetings

The strong medical presence in the capital provides a wealth of opportunity for event planners in the sector. Organisers can enjoy outstanding networking potential and access to the expertise and minds behind impressive innovation and research. London offers the opportunity to do business in a city that ensures achieving medical education objectives. ExCeL London find that life sciences conferences in London receive on average 15-20% more attendance from delegates and exhibitors, when compared to the same event in other cities¹.

A centre of excellence

MedTech and pharmaceutical organisations Smith & Nephew, GSK and AstraZeneca are just a few of the medical companies that call London home. The city is home to 120 biopharma companies, 1,500 biomedical researchers, 14 teaching hospitals and 50 clinical research centres. In addition, there are almost 90 commercial, research and development, and manufacturing medical companies in and around London.

Many key agencies and regulators are also based in London, including the Medical and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency, National Institute for Health Research (NIHR) and Medical Research

Council (MRC). The regulations that make the events industry what it is – safe, reliable, cutting edge and addressing the needs of patients – are created in London. All this helps to make London is one of the preferred international destinations for medical meetings and events.

Part of the Golden Triangle

The Golden Triangle links health science centres in three of the capital's premier academic institutions – University College London, Imperial College and King's College – with Oxford and Cambridge. They are supported by organisations such as MedCity, which exists to promote and grow the life sciences cluster encouraging life sciences investment, entrepreneurship and industry. A product of this collaboration is the new Francis Crick Institute in Central London, where around 1,250 scientists work in a cutting-edge centre of biomedical research and innovation.

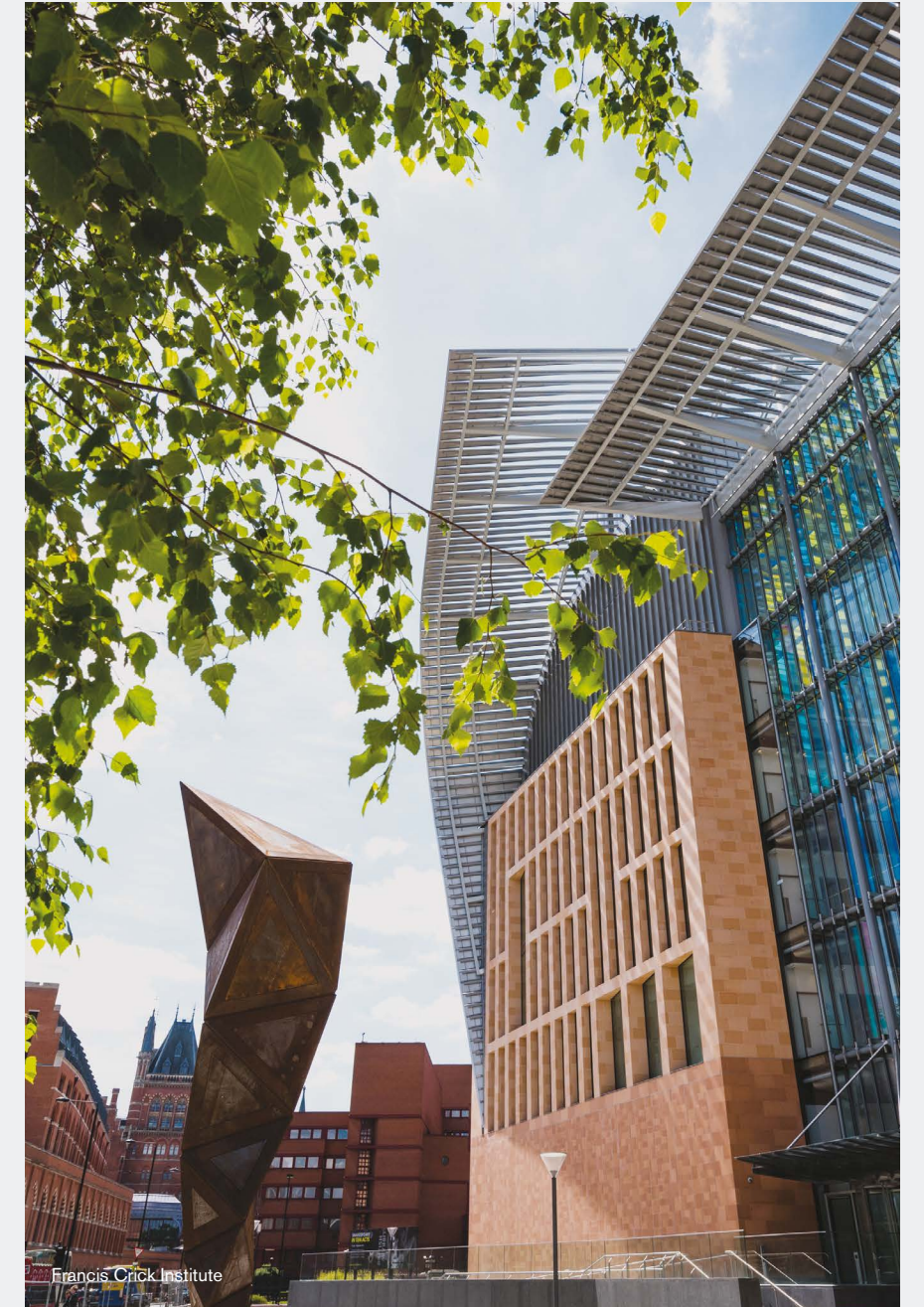
Diverse venues for educational events

Inspiring venues are a large part of London's appeal with phenomenal options in more than 1,000 venues and 153,000 hotel rooms as of 2nd January 2018 to suit any budget and to fit with any programme,

whether educational or corporate. Many medical institutions also have first class spaces, take BMA House or the award-winning Royal College of Physicians, who have versatile space including a medicinal garden to enhance any educational event. The Wellcome Collection is another option that combines venue, library and museum. And with the help of introductions from London & Partners, some of these respected institutions can provide speakers, ensuring your conference is a memorable and inspirational experience.

Flexible for any type of event

London has been home to many large medical congresses such as the Alzheimer's Association International Conference in July 2017 at ExCeL London, welcoming a record-breaking 5,600 attendees from 68 countries; and continues to be the top choice for associations with the European Society of Cardiology annual congress returning in 2021 and attracting over 30,000 heart specialists. But the capital also caters for smaller medical and pharmaceutical meetings, from training, symposia, product launches to incentives and motivational programmes for internal audiences.

Mapping medical activity

From Paddington to Hammersmith, West London hosts a powerful mix of research and development, manufacturing, academic study and healthcare, including Astra Zeneca, Genomic Medicine Centre and Imperial College Health Partners.

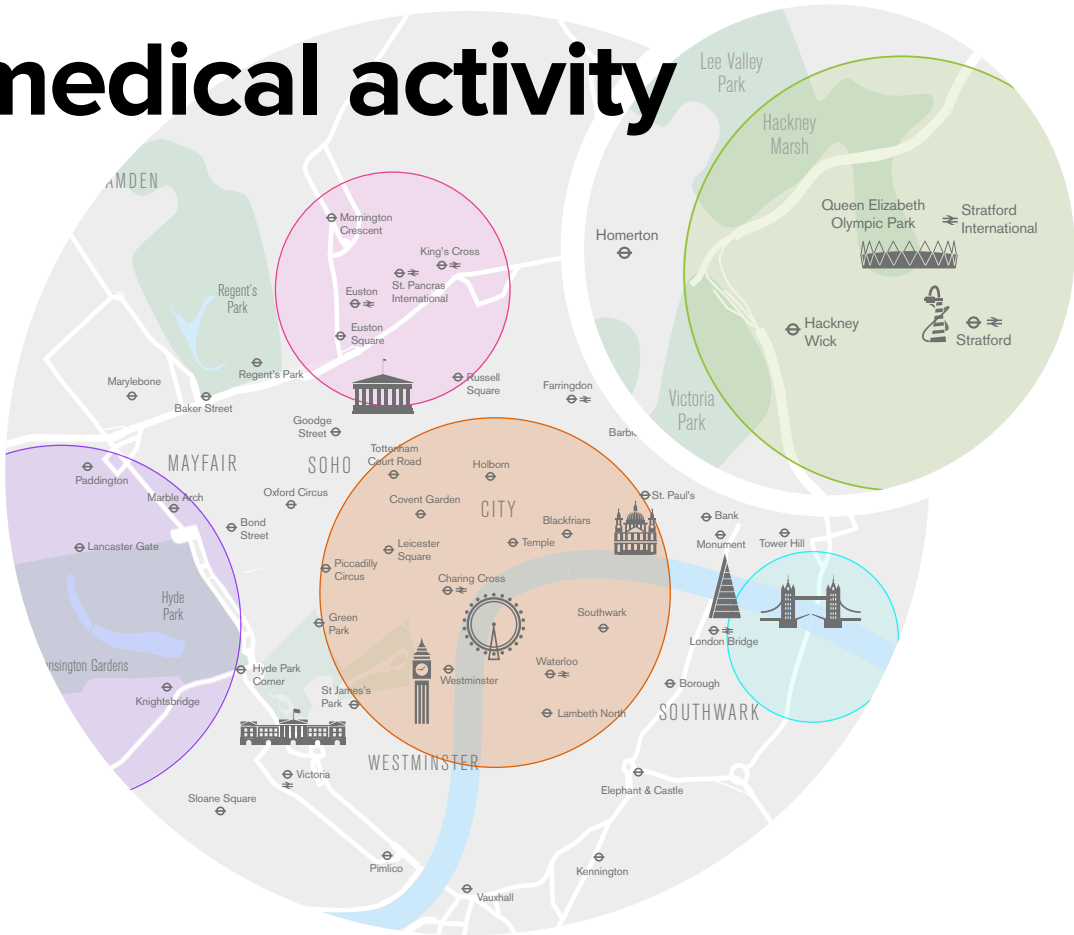
Westminster and the City host three of the industry’s four regulatory bodies based in London: Medical Research Council, Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency and National Institute for Health Research.

South of the Thames near Tower Bridge, pharma companies rub shoulders with King’s Health Partners and the Cell and Gene Therapy Catapult, created to lead the way in cell and gene therapy.

The area around King’s Cross St. Pancras, Euston and Bloomsbury is known as the Knowledge Quarter, comprising 35 organisations that cover culture, science, academia, research and media, including the British Library, Birkbeck College, the Francis Crick Institute, Google and the Institute of Physics.

East London is also contributing to London’s medical excellence, with scientific research and development hub Londoneast-uk Business and Technical Park in Dagenham; and UCL East, the university’s planned campus at Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park. This aims to overcome the conventional barriers between research, education, innovation, public engagement and collaboration.

Case Study

IFSO 22nd World Congress

This year saw the International Federation for the Surgery of Obesity and Metabolic Disorders (IFSO) 22nd World Congress taking place in the UK for the first time, held at London's QEII Centre in partnership with Central Hall Westminster from 29 August to 2 September 2017.

IFSO brings together world leaders in metabolic and bariatric surgery to educate, discuss and collaborate, with a scientific programme at the London event including a two-day International Conference on Sleeve Gastrectomy and 10 parallel scientific sessions during the main congress.

The British Obesity & Metabolic Surgery Society (BOMSS) coordinated the event on behalf of the federation. The successful bid was orchestrated by London &

Partners, with Professional Conference Organiser (PCO) partner TFI Group working closely with events teams at QEII and Central Hall to deliver the five-day event.

For the first time the congress had a non-medical speaker, with Sir Ranulph Fiennes, the world's greatest living explorer, delivering an inspirational speech at the Presidential Address.

Eija Hakkinen, Project Director for IFSO 2017, said: "The United Kingdom is a centre of excellence for obesity surgery. The British government and National Health Service (NHS) have prioritised obesity and metabolic disorders and as a result the UK, and in particular London, is a knowledge hub for the sector."

"IFSO has been a great project with almost 2,800 international delegates from 82 different countries, an excellent complex scientific programme of over 500 invited speakers and abstract presenters, with over 50 exhibitors. The congress exceeded its original target of 1,800 global delegates as well as succeeded in surpassing its initial sponsorship target by 300%."

Practical information for your medical meeting

A delegate’s ideal meeting will take just under 4 days including travel and on average event planners spend 25-30% of their budget on travel. So we know that location, accessibility and ease of getting around are important.⁴

Getting here

With six international airports – Heathrow, Gatwick, London City, Stansted, Luton and Southend – London has first-class connections with the rest of the world. It serves 336 destinations in all, supplied by a variety of legacy and low-cost carriers that ensure there is transportation to match every budget. In addition, Eurostar departs from St. Pancras International rail station, giving easy access to the rest of Europe.

Getting around

London’s public transport network covers the length and breadth of the city and offers several options. When it opens in late 2018, the Elizabeth line will provide a fast and direct link from Heathrow airport to the centre of London and to ExCeL London. The easiest way for delegates to travel around the city is with an Oyster Card, a contactless smart ticket that gives users a 30% discount across London’s transport network. The new Night Tube has extended London Underground services; it’s now open, giving 24 hour service on most lines on Fridays and Saturdays. Other options include excellent public transport services with buses and Santander bikes, DLR’s driverless trains to Canary Wharf and ExCeL, London’s licensed black cabs or the Thames Clipper. To plan your journey, visit tfl.gov.uk.

Investment brings improvements

From 2018, Crossrail – to be known as the Elizabeth line – will increase London’s rail capacity by 10%, radically cut journey times and allow passengers to get across London on one train. In addition, new rail services will make the rest of Europe more accessible, and from late 2017, Eurostar will be operating between London St. Pancras and Amsterdam, stopping at Brussels, Antwerp, Rotterdam and Schiphol Airport. Deutsche Bahn will also be running trains direct from Frankfurt, Cologne, Amsterdam and Rotterdam to London.
